Poetry - in *Make Me That Happy*, Rikki Santer offers up a saucy collection of spirited poems that make me want to laugh, cry, and celebrate.



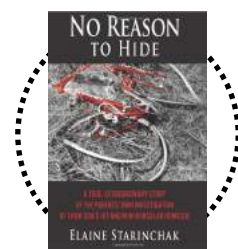
Scott Weibling
